

Gently tug on the ear, bringing it back to its original position. Insert the thermometer gently into the ear canal until it is completely sealed off. Squeeze and hold down the button for 1 second to complete the task. The thermometer should be removed and the temperature should be recorded. Changing the scale of the temperature If you want to convert from Celsius (°C) to Fahrenheit (°F), follow these steps: Check to see that the thermometer has been turned off. The following sequence will appear on the screen after approximately 8 seconds: Do you use a digital forehead thermometer that measures in degrees Celsius or Fahrenheit? It is possible to use a digital thermometer under the arm and add 1 degree to get a general sense of what the true temperature might be at any age (but don't count on it being 100 percent accurate.) After the age of four or five, you can begin to take your temperature in your mouth (see below for how to take an oral temperature). Do you use a forehead thermometer with a degree setting? You do not need to add or subtract any degrees when using a temporal thermometer or an ear thermometer, despite what some people may tell you otherwise. Report the temperature to the paediatrician and inform the doctor of which thermometer you used in order to obtain the reading. Is the accuracy of digital thermometers questionable? The temperature of the body is recorded by regular digital thermometers, which use electronic heat sensors. The accuracy of oral thermometer readings in older children and adults is generally high — provided that the mouth is kept closed while the thermometer is in place.
